**RE: Student Attendance "I-DLEACS" Online Participation
NJDOE State Assessment Scheduled for 2021**

I hope all of your scholars, friends, families and loved ones are safe given the pandemic.

As you know, students are required to:

- Attend school on a daily basis.
- NJDOE will Proceed with the Annual New Jersey Student Learning Assessments (NJSLA) for 20201 – [click on the attachment for DLEACS Yearly Assessments Calendar](#)
- **NJSLA Test window opens on 3/15/21 & closes on 6/11/21**

Quarter 1 is behind us. As we transition to quarter 2 in preparation for the state required NJSLA I need **ALL** families to be aware of the following:

Students come to the school and/or login to receive remote instruction are required to be **ON TIME**

When students attend on time, on a daily for each class:

- Students stay up-to-date with the required skills and concepts that they will be assessed on throughout the year

Therefore, note the following criterion to date:

1. ALL students must be **ON TIME FOR ALL CLASSES**. Students who login after 9:30AM are subject to being marked absent for the class or the day
2. When students login late they miss the objective of the lesson(s)
3. Cameras must be on and students are required to participate in class
4. All students are required to complete lessons for all subjects
5. All students are required to participate in all classes including "specialty" classes
6. All teachers take attendance **during** their respective online classes
7. All students will be graded on their participation and attendance for all classes
8. If you have a situation regarding assignments & online participation you are required to inform your child's teacher via DOJO and/or email to discuss solutions/resources in the best interest of the student(s)
9. Our TAs & administration are calling families frequently to ensure student attendance and check on families

We realize that some of our families have multiple children in different grades that meet online at the same time. Our faculty will continue to work with families encountering this dilemma.
