
## CHARTER SCHOOL FUNDING

**FACT:** CHARTER SCHOOLS receive only 73% OF PER PUPIL FUNDING (on average) compared to traditional districts.

Charter schools receive \$0 FOR FACILITIES FUNDING. On average, charter schools in New Jersey spend \$1,418 per student from designated per-pupil funding/operating revenue, each year, on facilities costs.
